- e) Consideration of a request from the Valdosta-Lowndes County Airport Authority to approve a Resolution authorizing acceptance of a Grant Agreement with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to proceed with construction of a new emergency generator, construction of an airfield electrical vault replacement and existing power feeds/lights circuit modifications, construction of airfield signs and lighting modification (LED), and implementation of a Wildlife Management Plan at the Valdosta Regional Airport (Project No. 3-13-0115-032-2014). – **Approved (6-0 Vote).**
