4. Public Hearings

- a) Consideration of an Ordinance for rezoning 3.59 acres from Mixed-Use Development (MXD) to Community-Commercial (C-C) as requested by Riverview Development, LLC (File No. VA-2014-05). The property is located 3819 North Valdosta Road. The Greater Lowndes Planning Commission reviewed this request at their July Regular meeting and recommended approval (8-0 vote). **Approved (7-0 Vote).**
