You may be tempted to increase water use on your lawn, more frequently wash your car, increase laundry cycles or take a long cooling shower. Whatever your summer traditions, be mindful of your water use. Did you know that collectively during spring and summer days in Valdosta, we often exceed peak daily consumption of twelve (12) million gallons a day? With a daytime population of approximately 65,000 people, that equates to more than 184 gallons per person per day. That's a lot of water.

There are a few simple things we can do that will make a big difference. Wash your car on the grass, don't run water while brushing your teeth, don't take extended showers, and most importantly, limit water use to the minimum required to sustain your flora and fauna. With your help, we will ensure one of our most precious gifts is around for many generations to come.

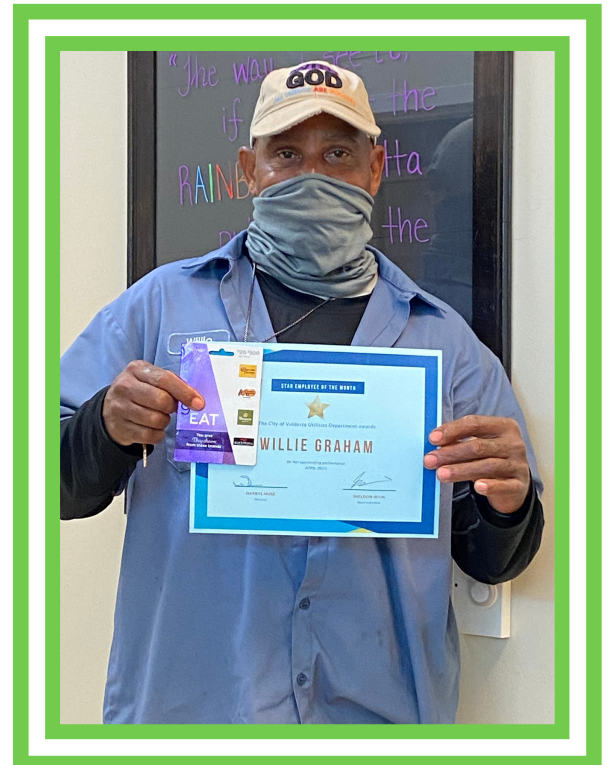
