Summary and Recommendations

6.1 Stormwater Modeling

City should acquire land whenever possible to protect streams, stream buffers, and ditches.

6.2 Infrastructure Flooding

With the development of a stormwater master plan for the primary stormwater system, the City has identified problem areas that will reduce flooding hazards related to major streams and waterways. Many of the common flooding complaints are related to infrastructure flooding that should be addressed by improving local drainage such as roadway inlets, pipes, swales and ditches.

CDM recommends using the primary stormwater system model as a benchmark to expand the analysis in detailed areas that should be retrofit to reduce local flooding.
