

Submit Your Preservation Award Nominations Today!

Nominations are being accepted for the 7th Annual Valdosta Preservation Awards. This program recognizes historic property owners who go "above and beyond" in their efforts to restore their historic buildings. Award winners are presented with a framed certificate signed by the Mayor and an award banner that can be displayed on their historic building.

Projects may be nominated for three categories: Outstanding Achievement (for major restoration projects) Distinguished Merit (for minor restoration projects), and Excellence in Compatible New Construction (for new buildings that are compatible with the historic district's character). There is also a Stewardship Award for owners of historic buildings who have consistently cared for and maintained their building. The Harold Bennett Lifetime Achievement Award recognizes an amazing individual for their contributions to historic preservation in Valdosta.

Friday, **April 24th** is the deadline to submit a nomination. Nomination forms can be downloaded from <u>www.valdostacity.com/planning</u> or by visiting the Planning and Zoning Division office at 300 N. Lee Street, Room 111.

The 2015 Valdosta Preservation Awards will be presented on May 21st at the Valdosta City Council meeting.

Welcome These New Board Members



Gateway Project Update

Below is the final rendering for the new Gateway Corridor signage on North Valdosta Road. Due to rainy weather, the holidays, and a gas line needing to be moved, construction has been delayed. However, trees have been ordered and are ready to be delivered. Hopefully, staff will start planting trees on March 2nd. Once the trees are in place, stormwater staff will then construct the sign. The estimated date of completion is March 31, 2015. The City of Valdosta was awarded a \$19,490 GATEway Grant from the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) — as part of \$1.9 million GDOT awarded to government entities across the state for community landscaping projects on state routes. Farm Days 5th Season Bringing Market Fresh Goods to Downtown

Valdosta Farm Days is ramping up for a 5th season at the historic Lowndes County Courthouse square. The market kicks off on May 2nd, and will be open from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. on the first and third Saturdays of each month through September (with a few exceptions) and every Saturday in June. Customers can expect to find local fresh produce, baked goods, meats, eggs, honey, plants, and other specialty items. We want to make it easy for you to come and shop with us. If there's no cash



in your wallet, no need to find an ATM – just stop by our Information Booth and use your debit card to receive Market tokens in exchange. Then, use your tokens to purchase anything at the Market. The tokens never expire and you receive cash change from vendors if your purchase is less than your token amount.

Have an EBT (food stamp) card? No problem! Your card is welcome at the market and thanks to the generous support of Wholesome Waves nutrition incentive program, Farm Days provides matching funds (up to \$50) to EBT shoppers. So, use your EBT card and double your money!

The farmer's market is just the beginning for spring events Downtown. Combining the love of art and Historic Downtown Valdosta, it is our pleasure to invite you to the summer Art Walks on First Fridays, May 1st and August 7th. We will also be featuring a wine and beer tasting experience at participating Art Walk locations. Wristbands for the wine and experience are available for \$20 per person with all proceeds going to the Public Art Advisory Committee. Participants of both the Art Walk and wine/beer ex-



perience will be given a Passport. These will be stamped at each Art Walk location. Turn in your completed Passport for a chance to win a fabulous gift.

Be Smart: Submit a Site Plan at the START!

The City of Valdosta <u>strongly encourages</u>. Site Plan submittal **BEFORE** full plan submittal. This allows staff the opportunity to comment on major components of the development, which can affect all aspects of the site. Items on the Site Plan should include setbacks, parking, buffering, access, detention, and landscaping. Each of these items has a significant impact on the location and layout of a building, which can affect the architectural and building plans. Unfortunately, if items are shown incorrectly on the Site Plan and a full set of plans has already been created based on incorrect information, the result is often wasted time and money.
