FALL IS UPON US!

The leaves are falling and the department has leaf-vacuum crews that circulate throughout the city routes that incorporate every street, meaning there is no need to call for leaf pickup. If you should have a question, comment or concern about the Public Works Department or its services, please call our office at 229.259.3588 or 229.259.3590.

The City of Valdosta offers a weekly curbside leaf and yard waste collection service to city residents. The city collects yard waste in the form of grass, leaves and brush.

Yard waste, household garbage, bulk-items, and recycling are collected on the same day. Brush, grass and leaves are all ground to produce mulch which is available **FREE** of charge to residents that visit the mulch site located at 3365 Val Tech Road.

Remember all piles larger than 4 ft. x 8 ft. are subjected to a pick-up fee that is added to your utility account.

COLLECTION GUIDELINES

- Place at the curb by **5 a.m.** on your scheduled pick-up day.
- Piles should not be placed under power wires and should not block drainage ditches or storm drains, obstruct sidewalks, or create a trafic hazard.
- Please do not mix other yard waste, branches/sticks, trash or recyclables with your leaf piles.
- Avoid parking cars in front of piles, which prohibits the crew from reaching the piles.
- Remember that there will not be any collection of yard debris on Thanksgiving, Chrismas Day or New Year's Day. Schedules will shift by one day following the holiday.

DID YOU KNOW?

The Public Works Department offers Roll-Off container rental service to city residents and businesses. When you have large projects, construction or demolition, or yard debris waste, give us a call for our competitive rates.

We currently have 20, 30, and 40 yard containers available. The different sizes can hold approximately:

- 20 yard container = 20 cubic yards of material, or 6 pickup truck loads of debris.
- 30 yard container = 30 cubic yards of material, or 9 pickup truck loads of debris.
- 40 yard container = 40 cubic yards of material, or 12 pickup truck loads of debris.



What can I place in the blue bin?

- ➤ Paper Newspaper, magazines, junk mail, office paper, cardboard boxes.
- ➤ Cans Aluminum, tin and steel.
- ➤ Glass Bottles and jars.
- ▶ Plastics #1 5 & 7 listed on the bottom.
