DID YOU KNOW??

Using personal protective equipment is essential, but it is generally the last line of defense after engineering controls, safe workplace practices, and administrative controls. Engineering controls involve physically changing a machine or work environment. Administrative controls involve changing how or when employees do their jobs, such as schedules and rotations to reduce exposures. Safe workplace practices involve training employees how to perform tasks in ways that reduce their exposure to workplace hazards.

Proper Personal Protective Equipment Use

TOOLBOX TALK

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is equipment worn to minimize exposure to hazards that cause workplace injuries and illnesses. All PPE should be maintained in a clean and reliable fashion. It should fit comfortably, encouraging worker use. If the PPE does not fit properly, it can make a difference in being safely covered or dangerously exposed. Employers must provide PPE to employees and ensure its proper use. Employers are also required to train each employee required to use PPE to know:

- When it is necessary
- What kind is necessary
- How to properly put it on, adjust, wear, and take it off
- The limitations of the equipment
- Proper care, maintenance, useful life, and disposal of the equipment 04


