Senior Construction Inspectors are responsible for on-site inspections of public infrastructure to ensure compliance with Valdosta City standards. Inspecting construction projects include water, sewer, curb, gutters, sidewalks, streets, storm water as well as driveways. They test new water mains, and work with utility companies as well as contractors during inspection visits and walk through infrastructure issues. Senior Construction Inspectors review all payment submittals to ensure compliance with contract documents and they inspect projects to ensure compliance with Land Disturbance permits.



During the Christmas holiday, Luis went to visit his parents in Homestead, Florida. During his stay, he called to make plans to visit some of his dearest friends (Cathy and Kenny Martin). Registration will be held at the school the student is zoned for.




Commander Leslie Manahan Appointed Police Chief of the Valdosta Police Department
